Potential hazard	At risk	Risk rating	Control measure
Injury	Adults and children	Low	The chicks are unable to injure through either pecking or scratching, posing no risk of injury to children or adults.
Escaping animals	Adults and children	Low	All animals are safely secured in appropriate housing. Providing all recommended procedures are followed there is no risk of escape.
Virus or germs	Adults and children	Low	Teachers and children are advised to keep fingers away from mouths until the contact session has ended and they have thoroughly washed their hands. Children's hand washing should be

			supervised and take place immediately after contact time. All contact points (for example door handles) to the washing facilities should be operated by staff who has not had contact with the animals.
Allergies	Adults and children	Low	Teachers to be aware of allergies of children likely to be in contact with animals.
Electrical equipment	Adults and children	Low	All equipment is low wattage and P.A.T tested.
